NEGATIVE COGGINS (within 12 months) and RABIES CERTIFICATE must be presented before a horse will be allowed to compete.

* USEF rules will apply, and the USEF rulebook will be used to resolve any questions. The judge's decisions are final.

* ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn by junior hunter riders and all riders over fences, and their use is suggested for all others.

* All classes are open to horses and ponies. All classes *except hunter classes* are open to riders of all disciplines.

* Walk-Trot riders are not eligible for any classes requiring a canter. Ages determined on January 1st. Novice Walk Trot is open to first year W/T riders.

* Beginner W/T/C is open to riders in their first or second year of showing W/T/C.

* Professional horsemen are eligible for Low Hunter, Green Horse, and Open Divisions only.

* A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Classes with less than three entries will earn points for year end awards, but no day-end awards will be presented.

* No refunds for dropped classes.

* Horses that kick should wear a red tail ribbon.

* A fall of horse or rider will result in disqualification. Any dangerous, sick, or unruly horses will be excused.

* Points for Championships will be awarded for first through sixth place as follows: 7-5-4-3-2-1. Points will accumulate for rider **except for Green Horse Division** where points will follow horse.

* Rider must show in at least three of the five shows in the series to be eligible for year-end awards. Rider will be assigned one back number for the Series (**Please bring it to each show**)

* Classes with more than 12 riders will be divided.
